Types of Events

1. Ready to Execute (RTE)

RTE programs are pre-approved and easy to implement. FSS related events keep funds on the installation and should be considered first.

2. Unit Developed Program (UDP)

Squadron leaders are given the discretion to create UDPs that capitalize on opportunities available in the local area. UDPs require prior approval through the Air Force Services Activity (AFSVC) and may take up to 30 days.

3. Free/Volunteer

Charitable work provides a cost effective team building activity that allows co-workers to see each other in a new light and can make a real difference in your community. Free events do not need approval, but we still need to capture the information.

How to host a UNITE event

1. Complete the POC Appointment Letter

Squadron Commanders will appoint a squadron Unite POC, in writing, to the FSS UNITE lead coordinator (C3).

2. Event Proposal

Meet with your installation C3 to discuss your objectives, event ideas, and to complete the "Event Proposal Form".

- 4. Submit After Action Information

The installation C3 largely won't be attending your events, so we are relying on you to provide detailed after action information to improve the program.

UNITE funds CANNOT be used to augment holiday parties on or off the installation. Units are responsible for expenses that exceed the alloted amount. UNITE funds CANNOT be combined with Unit Enhancement Funds or SM&W Funds. Private Org funds may be used.
